DO NOT DISCARD – IMPORTANT Notice Regarding Electricity Rates



November 8, 2021

Dear Residential or Small Business Customer:

The Town of Penfield has entered into a Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) program that leverages the buying power of Penfield’s residents and small businesses to provide competitive electricity options when compared against the last 12 months of RG&E default utility rates, multi-year fixed rates, and more renewable electricity while continuing to receive transmission and distribution service from Rochester Gas & Electric (RG&E).

Penfield CCA is a Town-authorized community choice aggregation program operated on behalf of the Town of Penfield by Good Energy, LP, the CCA Program Administrator.

Penfield CCA gives residents and small businesses an opportunity to *stabilize* electricity supply rates with a default fifty percent (50%) renewable product for all eligible accounts in the community, increasing individual buying power through a group purchase of electricity.

How does the program work?

As an eligible participant, you do not need to take any action—your electric account will be automatically enrolled in the CCA Program unless you choose to opt out by **December 8, 2021**. Constellation NewEnergy is the energy services company (“ESCO”) that will be your supplier of electricity for this program. There are no enrollment or switching fees for this transition. Your new electricity fixed rate will be **\$0.05733/kilowatt hour (kWh) beginning with your first available meter read after December 8, 2021 through December 2023.**

Will I still be a RG&E customer? RG&E will continue to be responsible for your electricity delivery, general maintenance, and response to power outages. **You will still receive one bill and pay RG&E**, and you can still take advantage of budget billing when you participate in the CCA Program.

About your New Electricity Plan: The rate for eligible participants of **\$0.05733/kWh** has a default of fifty percent (50%) Renewable Energy and is called **Penfield Green**. Fifty percent (50%) of this renewable energy is a New York State Environmental Disclosure Labeling Program compliant renewable product, while the remaining fifty percent (50%) contains the standard electric grid mix of energy. You may also decide to opt up to 100% renewable with **Penfield 100**. See details below:

*RG&E Trailing 12-month rate is without the addition of renewable energy above the state’s Clean Energy Standard. (RG&E rates change every month). **Your rate is automatically a fifty percent (50%) renewable product by default with Penfield Green. ***However, you can opt up and choose 100% Renewable Energy with Penfield 100.

With the CCA Program:

- You get rate stability with no month-to-month volatility
- There is no change in delivery service
- There are no termination or switching fees

What if you do not wish to participate?

Per the rules of the New York State Public Service Commission, CCA programs are required by law to inform you of your option to rescind (“opt out” of) your automatic enrollment with adequate notice prior to the scheduled switch. Penfield customers who do not choose to opt out will be automatically enrolled with Constellation NewEnergy under the terms stated above; RG&E will then provide their energy usage data and Assistance Program Participant (APP) status to Constellation NewEnergy.

Below is information you will need to exercise your opt-out rights:

If you DO NOT wish to participate in the Town of Penfield’s CCA program before it begins, you must opt out by **December 8, 2021**. You may also opt out at any time in the future at no cost.

If you wish to opt out, choose one of these three easy methods:

1. Mail: return the enclosed opt-out card with pre-paid postage envelope

If you have any questions or if you would like to leave the CCA program at any time with no termination fee you can call Constellation at (833) 475-5228. Customers may also call the utility to drop at any time. Representatives are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week to answer any questions you may have.
